**SERIES NOTES:** North Carolina A&T and Coastal Carolina have a short history together... They played against each other for the first time last season...Coastal came away with a 20-7 win at Aggie Stadium...CCU's history is short as it is in just its sixth year of playing college football...The Chanticleers play in the Big South conference along with Liberty, Charleston Southern, Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian, Stony Brook and VMI...The only other team the Aggies have ever played from the Big South is Liberty in 1992.

## Stepping Outside HBCU Football

Lately, the Aggies non-conference foes have been mostly future MEAC schools like Winston-Salem State and N.C. Central. With Winston-Salem State's retreat from the MEAC and N.C. Central entry into the MEAC, the Aggies non-conference games are likely to come outside of Black College Football. The Aggies are 4-6 in their last 10 matchups against schools who are not traditional historically black colleges or universities. Three of those wins came against Elon and one of those losses came against Division I Louisiana Lafayette. Two of the losses came in the NCAA playoffs against Wofford and Youngstown State.

The Aggies have won three out of their last five non-conference games with two wins over Winston-Salem State and a win over Johnson C. Smith.

### The Coastal Scouting Report

Coastal Carolina in many ways is similar to North Carolina A&T. The Chanticleers have a veteran quarterback in Zach MacDowall, and their offense has three different backs who can run the ball efficiently. The Chanticleers will rely heavily on running backs Tommy Fraser, Eric O'Neal and Jeremy Height. Each runner has over 100 yards rushing this season with Fraser leading the way with 135 yards on 29 carries. But only 35 yards separates the leading rusher from the third leading rusher – Jeremy Height. In the air, MacDowall has thrown for 495 yards and two touchdowns in three games, but he has also thrown four interceptions. Phillip Obah leads the Chanticleers defensively. He has 2 ½ tackles for loss and two sacks. Quinton Davis leads the team in sacks with three. Dasmond Stewart leads the team in tackles with 22.

### Inside the Numbers...

- 1** – In 12 seasons as a defensive coordinator at three different MEAC schools, Alonzo Lee's defenses have finished No. 1 in the conference five times.
- 3** -- The number of wins the Aggies have in the bank thus far. The Aggies won three games over the previous three seasons.
- 5** – The Aggies received five preseason honors. Senior Jarrell Herring earned preseason All-American honors from Consensus Draft Services. CDS also named senior linebacker Andre Thornton and junior offensive lineman Enoch Cohen preseason All-HBCU. Thornton and senior defensive end Tyre Glasper earned preseason second-team all-MEAC honors.
- 5** – Is the number of three-year starters the Aggies have on their 2009 defense.
- 6** – It has been six seasons since the Aggies have had the No. 1 defense in the conference. The defensive coordinator of that team was Alonzo Lee.
- 7** – Seven of Lee's 12 last defenses finished among in the top 40 defenses in the nation.
- 16** -- Is the number of sacks the Aggies posted last season. They have nine so far this season.
- 20**- Is the number of yards Dontavious Payne had on his first career as an Aggie.
- 20** – Is the number of tackles senior Andre Thornton needs to move into the Aggies top-10 list all-time. Thornton comes into the season with 234 career tackles.
- 38** – The number of straight games safety Nick Clement has played in as an Aggie.

### Chanticleer/Aggie connections

The Chanticleers have 15 players on their roster from the state of North Carolina, including two players from Greensboro. Defensive standout Phillip Obah is a Dudley graduate and has two sacks and 19 tackles on the season. Redshirt freshman D.J. McNeill is a running back who attended Page High School. He and Aggies cornerback Dashaun Graham were high school teammates. Junior safety Brian Sanders attended High Point Andrews. There is also one more connection. Tarvorris Jolly plays cornerback for CCU. He attended Shelby High School, the same high school that produced Aggies receiver Larry Raper.

### A Glance at the Aggies 2009 Opponents

Including Delaware State, who will forfeit a game to the Aggies this season, N.C. A&T's 11 2009 opponents were 63-64 last season. The good news for the Aggies is their first seven opponents were 30-49 last season. The bad news is, the final three opponents the Aggies will face were 27-9 in 2008, including defending MEAC Champion S.C. State. There is no difference in the Aggies schedule other than not playing Johnson C. Smith this season. Four of the Aggies opponents – Hampton, Bethune-Cookman, Florida A&M and S.C. State – had winning records last season. Two of the Aggies opponents – Coastal Carolina and Morgan State – had .500 records. Meanwhile, five of the opponents had losing records.

## Saturday's Captains vs. HU

The four men who walked out as captains for the Aggies on Saturday were wide receiver Giorgio Lowrance, senior quarterback Carlton Fears, senior defensive end Tyre Glasper and senior defensive lineman Adam Beal. All four players are seniors with two of the players – Beal and Glasper – being fifth-year seniors. Fears, a junior college transfer, was the only player who has been at N.C. A&T less than two years. Despite the Aggies having 51 players from North Carolina, Lowrance was the only captain on Saturday from North Carolina. Fears is from Georgia and Beal and Glasper are from Detroit.

### Recapng the Hampton Game

...The third game of the season has not been to pleasant for the Aggies lately...For the eighth straight year, the Aggies have lost their third ball game of the season...The last time the Aggies won their third game of the season came on Sept. 29, 2001 when they beat Norfolk State 43-0.

...In the fourth quarter on Saturday, Hampton's Brandon Roundtree picked off a Lewis Kindle pass at the Aggies 5-yard line and returned it for a touchdown. It was the first time an opponent has returned an interception for a touchdown against the Aggies since Akeem Goode did it for Delaware State on Oct. 13, 2007.

... The Aggies woes contineud on television. ESPN started televising MEAC games in 2005. The Aggies are still looking for their first win on the channel. The Aggies loss to Hampton dropped their record to 0-6 on ESPN. Three of those losses have come against the Pirates.

...Seven times last season, the Aggies gave up 350 yards seven times last season. Over the first three games this season, the Aggies have yet to allow an opponent more than 350 yards. Only two opponents failed to get more than 150 yards rushing against the Aggies in 2008. No opponent has rushed more than 150 this season.

## THE FORFEIT

The Aggies will not play Delaware State this season. The Hornets decided to forfeit a game to the Aggies after running into a scheduling conflict with the University of Michigan they could not relinquish because of financial concerns. The Aggies were to play the Hornets on Oct. 17, but instead the Aggies will be given a victory that day. The Aggies will not be able to count the game as a victory until Oct. 17. This essentially means the Aggies will have two bye weeks in 2009.

## THREE-GAME IMPROVEMENT

The Aggies have surrendered 47 points over the first three games of the season. It is the fewest points the Aggies have surrendered over the first three games since 2003 when they gave up just 42 points over the first three games. Their best showing of the decade came in 2001 when they gave up just seven points over the first three games.

This season, the Aggies have obtained three weekly honors in three weeks this season. After Week 1, Jarrell Herring earned Defensive Player of the Week. Jason Valmont and Mike Mayhew earned weekly honors the next week. Valmont earned Offensive Lineman of the Week and Mayhew captured Rookie of the Week.

## CAN HE BE BLOCKED?

Tyre Glasper leads the Aggies in sacks and he continues to climb up the Aggies all-time sacks list. On the season, Glasper has eight quarterback hurries and 3.5 sacks. Glasper career-high in sacks is 5.5, so he is well on his way to eclipsing that mark. The Aggies all-time sack leader is Chris McNeil who amassed an amazing 30 sacks over two seasons. Glasper currently has 12 career sacks.

## A YEAR AGO AGAINST THE CHANTICLEERS

The Chanticleers will get a whole new look from the Aggies this season from the offensive sense. The Aggies offense failed to score any points against the Chanticleers in a 20-7 loss. The Aggies only score came on defense. There will be a different starting quarterback and the participants in the running game will be different. Giorgio Lowrance is the only receiver on this year's team who caught a pass in last season's game at Aggie Stadium. He made two catches for 22 yards. Defensively, Andre Thornton led the Aggies with 11 tackles and linebacker Jamison Hedgepeth intercepted a pass in the end zone for an Aggies touchdown. An injury prevented Zach MacDowall from playing in last year's game. Brandon Whitley led the Chanticleers on the receiving end with four catches for 40 yards. Kenny Jones and Jonathan Morgan also caught passes for the Chanticleers. On the defensive side, Greensboro native Phillip Oboh had eight tackles with three for loss and a half sack. Derrick Frasier ended the game with six tackles.

## SUPER ROOKIE

Sophomore Mike Mayhew has scored a touchdown in each of his first three games as an Aggie. He is the first Aggies rookie to score a touchdown in each of his first three games. Mayhew is a unique rookie in that he is a sophomore because of being a Prop player last season. Therefore, he is not eligible for any Aggie freshman records. Barry Turner owns the rookie rushing record for N.C. A&T with 556 yards in 1990. Al Holland owns the rookie record for touchdowns with 12.

## THE MANY FACES OF THE AGGIE QUARTERBACK

With the appearance of freshman quarterback Lewis Kindle on Saturday, the North Carolina A&T quarterback roll added another name. North Carolina A&T has had many different quarterbacks over the past seven seasons. The Aggies have had eight quarterbacks see action in the past six seasons. That is a little more than a different quarterback each season. The one thing that has been consistent for the Aggies at the quarterback position is the starter on opening day. For the past three seasons, Herb Miller has started the opener for N.C. A&T. The Aggies will have a quarterback competition in practice this week for the top job between Carlton Fears and Lewis Kindle.

## NO POINTS BEYOND THE FIRST

The Aggies surrendered their first points in the second half last week when the Hampton Pirates scored 10 points. Seven of those points, however, were scored by the Pirates defense. The Aggies defense still has surrendered only three points all season in the second half. In fact, the Aggies didn't allow Norfolk State to score over the final 44 minutes of the game. A week earlier, the Aggies prevented the Rams from scoring over the final 34 minutes of the game in a 19-10 win.

## DEFENSIVE RANKINGS

North Carolina A&T's defense has taken giant steps from the bottom of the MEAC defensive rankings. They rank No. 2 in scoring defense and No. 3 in total defense. The Aggies also have the third best rush and pass defense in the conference.

## FAMILIAR TERRITORY

Alonzo Lee is the fifth head coach the Aggies have had in the last eight years. But this time around Lee had some familiarity to his staff. Defensive back coach Travis Oliver has been with the Aggies through four of the five administrations. Oliver enters his sixth season at N.C. A&T, so the Aggies secondary has pretty much had stability over the past few seasons. Offensive coordinator/offensive line-men coach Chennis Berry spent three seasons at N.C. A&T (2003-2005). Berry is familiar with some of the recent Aggie graduates, so there was not a bid adjustment for him returning. Defensive line/special teams coordinator Tyrone Odums was the Aggies defensive coordinator last season. Running backs coach George Ragsdale has been on the staff the last four seasons. He even had a stint as the Aggies interim head coach in 2008. And of course, there is Lee, who was the Aggies defensive coordinator from 2003-05. He recruited defensive line-men Tyre Glasper and Adam Beal.

## THE MAD TACKLER

Andre Thornton is slowly moving up the all-time tackles list for N.C. A&T. He has 241 career tackles, 19.5 tackles for loss and 10 pass deflections for his career. On Saturday, Thornton recorded seven tackles and a sack. Thornton has averaged 73.7 tackles per season since being an Aggie. At that pace, he will come close to finishing with 300 career tackles, which would put him in the top 7 all-time. He needs just 20 tackles to move into the top 10 all-time on the list.

## **ON THE ROAD AGAIN**

If the Aggies want to finish above .500 for the first time in six seasons, they will have to make some leeway on the road. Five of the Aggies final seven games will come on the road. On Sept. 5, the Aggies ended a final woeful streak that stemmed from the 2005 season. Before beating Winston-Salem State, the Aggies had not won on an opponent's home field in 22 games. That is over thanks to the Aggies 19-10 win at Bowman Gray Stadium. Their last win on a team's home field came on Nov. 1, 2003 when the Aggies defeated Bethune-Cookman 13-7 in Daytona Beach, Fla. In fact, in the Aggies last 40 games away from Aggie Stadium, they are just 9-31 dating back to 2002. The Aggies last win away from Aggie Stadium was Oct. 8, 2005 when they defeated Morgan State 40-33 in overtime at FedEx Field. A win over Coastal Carolina will give them two wins away from home for the first time since 2005.

## **THE YOUTH MOVEMENT**

On offensive, North Carolina A&T started just two seniors – quarterback Carlton Fears and receiver Giorgio Lowrance – Saturday night against Hampton. That number could decrease depending on what the Aggies decided to do at the quarterback position this week. Left guard Kreg Carter was the only junior who started, the rest were rookie sophomores, sophomores, true freshmen and redshirt freshmen. The Aggies started five sophomores with on of them – Mike Mayhew – playing as rookie sophomore. There were also two true freshmen who found themselves in the starting lineup, tight end James Thomas and receiver Larry Raper.

## **WHEN DID THEY KNOW**

- During his 12 seasons as a defensive coordinator, Lee coached 13 All-Americans. Those players were either AFCA, Associated Press or SBN Black College All-Americans.
