The NCCU Scouting Report

North Carolina Central will continue its series of road games to start the season. The Eagles have already played Hampton, Liberty and Duke on the road this season. In fact, after playing N.C. A&T at Aggie Stadium this weekend, the Eagles will go on the road again to play Division I FCS power Appalachian State on Oct. 10. The Eagles have a veteran running game with junior running backs Tim Shankle and Tony McCord leading the way. Shankle has 262 yards and a touchdown on the season, while McCord has compiled 100 yards on 25 carries this season. Sophomore Michael Johnson, a transfer out of Tulsa, has taken the majority of the snaps at quarterback. He has completed 51.5 percent of his passes and has four touchdowns and four interceptions. Defensively, the Eagles are led by defensive tackle Teryl White. White has 24 tackles, four tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks.

Inside the Numbers...

- 1** – In 12 seasons as a defensive coordinator at three different MEAC schools, Alonzo Lee’s defenses have finished No. 1 in the conference five times.
- 3** -- The number of wins the Aggies have in the bank thus far. The Aggies won three games over the previous three seasons.
- 5** – The Aggies received five preseason honors. Senior Jarrell Herring earned preseason All-American honors from Consensus Draft Services. CDS also named senior linebacker Andre Thornton and junior offensive lineman Enoch Cohen preseason All-HBCU. Thornton and senior defensive end Tyre Glasper earned preseason second-team all-MEAC honors.
- 5** – Is the number of three-year starters the Aggies have on their 2009 defense.
- 6** – It has been six seasons since the Aggies have had the No. 1 defense in the conference. The defensive coordinator of that team was Alonzo Lee.
- 7** – Seven of Lee’s 12 last defenses finished among in the top 40 defenses in the nation.
- 16** -- Is the number of sacks the Aggies posted last season. They have nine so far this season.
- 20**- Is the number of yards Dontavious Payne had on his first career as an Aggie.
- 20** – Is the number of tackles senior Andre Thornton needs to move into the Aggies top-10 list all-time. Thornton comes into the season with 234 career tackles.
- 39** – The number of straight games safety Nick Clement has played in as an Aggie.

Eagle/Aggie connections

As expected, N.C. Central has quite a few players from the state of North Carolina. But the Eagles don’t have any players from Greensboro. Only one player, punter Brian Hasselsberger (Northwest Guilford), played at a Guilford County School. The Aggies are known for their Detroit 3 in defensive linemen Jarrell Herring, Tyre Glasper and Adam Beal. The Eagles also have a Detroit native in offensive lineman Jermere Nickerson. There are also a few Hillside High connections. Eagles starting quarterback Michael Johnson attended Hillside along with Aggies right guard Thomas Hearn.

A Glance at the Aggies 2009 Opponents

Including Delaware State, who will forfeit a game to the Aggies this season, N.C. A&T’s 11 2009 opponents were 63H-64 last season. The good news for the Aggies is their first seven opponents were 30-49 last season. The bad news is, the final three opponents the Aggies will face were 27-9 in 2008, including defending MEAC Champion S.C. State. There is no difference in the Aggies schedule other than not playing Johnson C. Smith this season. Four of the Aggies opponents – Hampton, Bethune-Cookman, Florida A&M and S.C. State – had winning records last season. Two of the Aggies opponents – Coastal Carolina and Morgan State – had .500 records. Meanwhile, five of the opponents had losing records.

Saturday's Captains vs. HU

The four men who walked out as captains for the Aggies on Saturday were wide receiver Giorgio Lowrance, senior quarterback Carlton Fears, senior defensive end Tyre Glasper and senior defensive lineman Adam Beal. All four players are seniors with two of the players – Beal and Glasper – being fifth-year seniors. Fears, a junior college transfer, was the only player who has been at N.C. A&T less than two years. Despite the Aggies having 51 players from North Carolina, Lowrance was the only captain on Saturday from North Carolina. Fears is from Georgia and Beal and Glasper are from Detroit.

Recaping the Coastal Game

...The 304 yards rushing surrendered by the Aggies on Saturday was the most rushing yards an Aggies team associated with head coach Alonzo Lee has surrendered in a game. Lee served as the Aggies defensive coordinator from 2003-05. The most yards his defense had surrendered before Saturday's game was 301 yards by S.C. State on Nov. 20, 2004.

... For the second straight week, sophomore running back Mike Mayhew ripped off a run of 50 yards or more. Against Hampton, he scored on a 59-yard touchdown run. Against the Chanticleers, he had a 56-yard run in the first quarter. Mayhew is fifth in the conference in rushing.

... Freshman Aggies punter Alex Grubb booted a 59-yard punt against Coastal Carolina on Saturday. It was Grubb's fourth punt of 50 yards or more. It was his second 59-yarder of the season. Grubb has also put nine punts inside the 20, five punts inside the 10 and has placed the ball inside the opponent's 3-yard line three times.

... For the first time this season, Mike Mayhew failed to score at least one touchdown in a game. Mayhew became the first Aggie rookie to score at least one touchdown in each of his first three games. Mayhew has 270 yards rushing and three touchdowns to start the season.

THE FORFEIT

The Aggies will not play Delaware State this season. The Hornets decided to forfeit a game to the Aggies after running into a scheduling conflict with the University of Michigan they could not relinquish because of financial concerns. The Aggies were to play the Hornets on Oct. 17, but instead the Aggies will be given a victory that day. The Aggies will not be able to count the game as a victory until Oct. 17. This essentially means the Aggies will have two bye weeks in 2009.

CONFERENCE HONORS

MEAC Weekly honors have been hard to come by the past few seasons for the Aggies. Last season, the Aggies collected just one weekly honor when Quay Long earned MEAC Rookie of the Year. This season, the Aggies have obtained three weekly honors in three weeks this season. After Week 1, Jarrell Herring earned Defensive Player of the Week. Jason Valmont and Mike Mayhew earned weekly honors the next week. Valmont earned Offensive Lineman of the Week and Mayhew captured Rookie of the Week.

CAN HE BE BLOCKED?

Tyre Glasper leads the Aggies in sacks and he continues to climb up the Aggies all-time sacks list. On the season, Glasper has eight quarterback hurries and 3.5 sacks. Glasper career-high in sacks is 5.5, so he is well on his way to eclipsing that mark. The Aggies all-time sack leader is Chris McNeil who amassed an amazing 30 sacks over two seasons. Glasper currently has 12 career sacks.

GREAT AGGIE PERFORMANCES AGAINST NCCU

North Carolina Central seems to bring out the best against in N.C. A&T. Over the 85 years the series has been in existence, there have been some great performances by Aggies against N.C. Central. The following list is a look at some of those top games.

November 24, 1949

Red Jackson launched a 90-yard touchdown to Athie Garrison to lead N.C. A&T to a 33-6 win over the Eagles.

November 22, 1975

Recently inducted N.C. A&T Sports Hall of Famer Ellsworth Turner passed for 255 yards and two touchdowns on 14-for-29 passing to lead the Aggies to a 34-16 win over the Eagles.

November 18, 1978

Freshman Charlie Sutton rushed for a school-record 243 yards on a school-record 44 carries to lead the Aggies to a 17-13 win in Durham. Sutton also scored two touchdowns.

November 16, 1985

Sophomore Stoney Polite rushed for 208 yards and a touchdown on 29 carries to lead the Aggies to a 28-19 win.

November 15, 1986

Alan Hooker passed for 264 yards and three touchdowns on 15-for-28 passing to lead N.C. A&T to a convincing 35-13 win over NCCU.

August 31, 2003

The Aggies intercepted five N.C. Central passes led by Joey Lance, who picked off two passes for 63 yards. Lance was named the Aggies defensive most valuable player.

September 5, 2005

Brandon Sweeney rushed for 150 yards and three touchdowns on 32 carries. He even scored a go-ahead touchdown for the Aggies in the fourth quarter, but it wasn't enough in a heartbreaking 23-22 loss to the Eagles.

A YEAR AGO AGAINST THE EAGLES

N.C. Central jumped out to a 21-0 lead thanks in large part to Tim Shankle. Shankle scored two touchdowns early and finished the game with 55 yards on 12 carries. Shankle's running back mate Tony McCord is back this season. McCord had 42 yards on 16 carries in last season's game. Central receiver DeMarcus Hill, who only has one reception this season, caught a 5-yard touchdown pass to start the Eagles 21-point unanswered streak. Alex Winters also scored a touchdown for the Eagles, but he scored his defensively. Winters scooped up a Carlton Fears fumble and returned it 38 yards. Winters also made eight tackles in the game. This season, Winters has 16 tackles and an interception. For the Aggies, Carlton Fears made the start and rushed for 82 yards on 14 carries. Nigel Tomlin, who has not played this season, had a career game a year ago with 110 yards and two touchdowns on 13 carries. The Aggies leading receiver last season was Giorgio Lowrance who had three catches for 32 yards.

AN AGGIES WIN MEANS

...The Aggies will be able to end a two-game slide, and remove any thought of what happened last season. The Aggies won their first two ball games last season but lost six straight after the promising start. A win will be big in perishing that thought.

...The Aggies will end a three-game losing streak to the Eagles. The Aggies once had a 13-game winning streak against the Eagles that extended through the 90's into the new millennium. But the Eagles have been able to rattle off wins in three out of the last four meetings. The last time the Eagles won four straight over N.C. A&T was in the early 70's.

...The Aggies will improve to 5-2-1 against N.C. Central at Aggie Stadium. Before 2007's game at Aggie Stadium, the Eagles had not played at the Aggies home in 16 years.

THE MANY FACES OF THE AGGIE QUARTERBACK

With the appearance of freshman quarterback Lewis Kindle on Saturday, the North Carolina A&T quarterback roll added another name. North Carolina A&T has had many different quarterbacks over the past seven seasons. The Aggies have had eight quarterbacks see action in the past six seasons. That is a little more than a different quarterback each season. The one thing that has been consistent for the Aggies at the quarterback position is the starter on opening day. For the past three seasons, Herb Miller has started the opener for N.C. A&T. The Aggies will have a quarterback competition in practice this week for the top job between Carlton Fears and Lewis Kindle.

IT'S A FAMILY AFFAIR

Quay Long is not the first person in his family to play for a historically black college or university. In fact, he is the third of four brothers to play college football for an HBCU. And he is the third brother to play in the secondary for an HBCU. Long's brother Vontrae played safety for Howard from 1999-02. Vontrae Long was the MEAC Rookie of the Year in 1999 and he was a three-time first-team All-MEAC selection as well as a three-time All-American. Long's brother Brandon Long played for Livingstone College 2004-07.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY

Alonzo Lee is the fifth head coach the Aggies have had in the last eight years. But this time around Lee had some familiarity to his staff. Defensive back coach Travis Oliver has been with the Aggies through four of the five administrations. Oliver enters his sixth season at N.C. A&T, so the Aggies secondary has pretty much had stability over the past few seasons. Offensive coordinator/offensive line-men coach Chennis Berry spent three seasons at N.C. A&T (2003-2005). Berry is familiar with some of the recent Aggie graduates, so there was not a bid adjustment for him returning. Defensive line/special teams coordinator Tyrone Odums was the Aggies defensive coordinator last season. Running backs coach George Ragsdale has been on the staff the last four seasons. He even had a stint as the Aggies interim head coach in 2008. And of course, there is Lee, who was the Aggies defensive coordinator from 2003-05. He recruited defensive line-men Tyre Glasper and Adam Beal.

THE MAD TACKLER

Andre Thornton is slowly moving up the all-time tackles list for N.C. A&T. He has 241 career tackles, 19.5 tackles for loss and 10 pass deflections for his career. On Saturday, Thornton recorded three tackles and an interception. Thornton has averaged 73.7 tackles per season since being an Aggie. At that pace, he will come close to finishing with 300 career tackles, which would put him in the top 7 all-time. He needs just 17 tackles to move into the top 10 all-time on the list.

OVERTIME RULES

The NCAA tiebreaker system established in 1996 will be used when a game is tied after four periods. NCAA football-playing rules apply. The officials will escort the captains (Rule 3-1-1) to the center of the field for the coin toss. The referee shall toss a coin at mid-field in the presence of no more than four captains from each team and another game official, first designating the field captain of the visiting team to call the coin toss. The winner of the toss shall choose one of the following options:

1. Offense or defense, with the offense at the opponent's 25-yard line to start the first series.
2. Which end of the field shall be used for both series of that overtime period.

Note: The winner of the toss may not defer his choice.

The loser of the toss shall exercise the remaining option for the first extra period and shall have the first choice of the two options for subsequent even-numbered extra periods. An extra period shall consist of two series with each team putting the ball in play by a snap at the designated 25-yard line. Each team retains the ball during a series until it scores or fails to make a first down. The team scoring the greater number of points during the regulation and extra periods shall be declared the winner. There shall be an equal number of series in each extra period, except if one team scores during a period other than on the try. Beginning with the third extra period, teams scoring a touchdown must attempt a two-point try.

AGGIE vs. CENTRAL OVERTIME GAMES

August 31, 1996: North Carolina A&T 38, N.C. Central 31 OT

The Aggie-Eagle rivalry had seen everything except the two teams playing in August and overtime. Fans got both in 1996. The Aggies surrendering of a 28-6 lead was complete when quarterback Brad McAdams connected with Monte' Southerland for a 42-yard touchdown to give the Eagles a 31-28 lead with 2:30 remaining. It appeared the then Division II Eagles were poised for victory when Aggies quarterback Ben Garrett had his pass intercepted by Trei Oliver. But the Eagles were called for roughing the passer, giving the Aggies life. Luther Leak's 27-yard field goal sent the game into overtime. The game was also one of the first in the nation to test the NCAA's new overtime rules. Mike Basnight gave the Aggies the lead with a 7-yard touchdown for the win. The Eagles drive stalled at the Aggies 13.

September 1, 2002: N.C. Central 33, N.C. A&T 30 OT

It was the game in which the streak came to an end. The Eagles had lost 13 straight to the Aggies, including all nine games in the Aggie-Eagle Classic series played in Raleigh since '94. It appeared the Aggies were headed for 14 straight when they took a 27-0 lead in the first half. The Eagles scored 27 unanswered points capped off by a 1-yard touchdown on a quarterback sneak by Lawrence Fuller with 4:50 remaining in regulation. In overtime, Pat Simcox gave the Aggies a 30-27 lead. The field goal meant if the Eagles scored a touchdown, it would end the game. The Eagles benefited from two consecutive pass interference calls on the Aggies that placed the ball on the Aggies 2. Donnie Pippen carried the ball over the goal line on a toss sweep for a 2-yard score that ended the streak.

THE ROSTER BREAKDOWN

The Aggies are hoping for success this season, but they definitely built for the future. The Aggies roster consists of 31 true freshmen and six redshirt freshmen. There are also 21 sophomores on the roster to go along with 16 juniors and 14 seniors. The N.C. A&T football team is represented by 14 states and Washington, D.C. By far North Carolina is represented the most with 51 players from the Old North State. The state of Florida is represented well with eight players on the roster. The Aggies roster also has six players from Georgia and three players apiece are from California, Michigan and Maryland. The other states represented include Louisiana, New York, South Carolina, Kentucky, Alabama, New Jersey and Tennessee.

DEFENSIVE AGGIE

Brandon Jackson recorded his second double-figure tackle game when he posted 12 tackles against Coastal Carolina. Jackson's performance moved him into fourth in the conference in tackles. The last Aggie to lead the conference in tackles was Rodney Edwards in 1992. Jackson is averaging 8.5 tackles per game.

BEHIND THE LINE

Jarrell Herring is tied for the league-lead in tackles for loss with 6.5. Herring is tied with Hampton's Kendrick Ellis.

MEANINGFUL INTERCEPTIONS

Quay Long is one of eight players in the MEAC with two interceptions this season. Long's interceptions have been key for the Aggies this season. His first interception was returned for 40 yards, which set up a 25-yard touchdown pass from Carlton Fears to Wallace Miles. Long's interception against the Chanticleers came as they were driving deep into Aggie territory. But Long came away with a pick in the end zone for a touchback that halted the Chanticleers' drive.

ALONZO LEE HEAD COACH



- In 12 seasons as a defensive coordinator at Morgan State, Hampton and North Carolina A&T, Lee has had the No. 1 defense in the MEAC five times.

- During his 12 seasons as a defensive coordinator, Lee coached 13 All-Americans. Those players were either AFCA, Associated Press or SBN Black College All-Americans.
